Our Mission:

Touchstone Golf Foundation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to improving our communities through service, education and charitable efforts by raising funds through golf related activities, and by promoting the enjoyment of and the values learned through the game of golf.

<u>Program requirements:</u>

- 6.5 hours (1 shift) volunteered at the course each week. Breaks given. (5.0 minimum in Winter months)
- 30 hours community service a year (not less than 15 hours in two calendar quarters).
 - o Youth Programs, Church, Charity Tournaments, Hole-in-one, etc...
- Wear official hat and nametag while on duty
- Valid driver license, Drug screen and Background check required

A volunteer's duties will include:

- (1) Greeting and assisting visitors/players to the golf course to ensure a fun and safe experience.
- (2) Providing advice to further the golfer's understanding and appreciation of the game and to improve the pace of play.
- (3) Raising funds for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes.
- (4) Providing support to organizations that conduct golf programs and events for deserving youth; especially those organizations that have programs targeting youth from disadvantaged backgrounds, at risk and minority youth, and individuals with disabilities.
- (5) Assisting Tournament Director and non-profit charitable/service organizations with the management of golf tournaments and other related functions (e.g. hole-in-one contest).
- (6) Assisting with other charitable tasks as determined from time to time.
- (7) Other tasks consistent with the mission and vision of the foundation.

Benefits and privileges are provided to enhance your ability to remain engaged in the game of golf and with your host course and constituents as you perform charitable activities. These benefits may change from time to time at the sole discretion of the host property. Your host course currently provides access to the following benefits: Free green fees anytime on weekdays and Weekends/Holidays after 12:00 pm, 50% off meals and some non-alcoholic beverages during shift, one free bucket of range balls daily, 10% discount on merchandise. (Tee time reservations may be permitted by the General Manager at off-peak times. However, times may be moved without notice based on demand for paying guests. Benefits are subject to change)
