4th of July fireworks at The Club was another great success! Now that we know what to expect, I believe it was better than last years'. There were definitely more people on the course that evening. However, most everyone was very respectful of the course. A special thank you to Anita Lochhead, Cathy Patience, and Al Smith for volunteering to help clean up the course the next morning.

Overall, the golf course is holding up well to the summer stress. The cooler temperatures during the last week of July helped tremendously in turf recovery in the weaker areas of the course. The 2 inches of rain wasn't bad either!!! Up until then, course had been left out of the monsoon moisture. As we head into August, the nighttime temperatures will begin to drop by a few degrees which will aid the recovery of any weak/thin turf areas. To aid in this process, we ask that you, please avoid any wet/dry/thin turf areas with your golf cart.

Have you noticed the Chipping Green bunker was renovated? The face of the bunker was lowered so you can see out onto the green when you hit and it was sodded. PLEASE do not enter and exit from the newly sodded area. It's the most heavily used bunker and the additional stress to the new sod is unnecessary.

A few reminders:

- Those that have handicap flags are the only ones allowed past the yellow stakes with their carts. All others must direct their carts to the paths and keep on it well past the next teeing area.
- All par 3's are Cart Path Only
- Please thoroughly rake your bunker after hitting and exit from the rear not the front face.
- Bunker rakes are to be placed in the bunker with the rake handle resting on the turf.

Greens Aerification this year will take place on August 22nd through 24th. The entire course will be closed these days and will reopen on Thursday, August 25th. Once completed, we will begin work on Tees, Approaches and Fairway/Rough areas.

Thanks to all the ladies and their guests who helped with and played in the Fancy Fox 2022. We hope everyone had a great time.

Lastly, I am saddened to announce the departure of one of our key personnel in Golf Course Maintenance. Our Equipment Technician, Andrew Picard will be leaving us in the next week or so. Andrew has been with Fox Hill for over 5 years and was instrumental in keeping all the golf course equipment operating properly and safely. Thank you Andrew for all your hard work, and best of luck at your new facility!

First of all, pay attention to the column headings. This will help you to properly fill out the sign in sheet. Secondly, please sign in with both your name and member number. And lastly, remember, grandchildren 23 and under are covered on your membership.

Do not sign them in as guests or you will be charged. If you bring your children and grandchildren over the age of 23 they must be signed in as guests.
