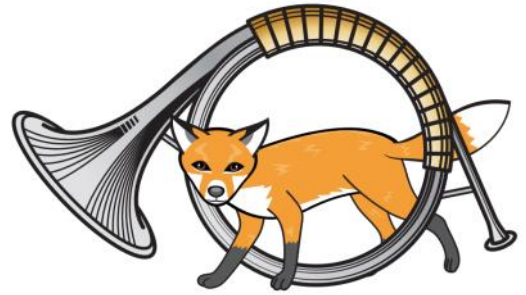

First I would like to thank all the Members and their Guests that played in the Fox Hunt. We hope that you all had a great time. We're already planning for next year's 50th Fox hunt. A special thank you to Jeff and Randi Pfeiffer for providing breakfast burritos to the Turf Team. I appreciate you helping to keep the crew moral at a high level.

If you've been out recently, I hope you've noticed many of the damaged areas from winter have healed in nicely. It's encouraging to see the results of all the seeding we did in the spring. Now that the heat is on, I would ask all golfers to avoid driving through any dry turf areas. The aging irrigation system does not provide the best of water coverage everywhere and the extra wear from carts only makes those areas worse. Let's hope Mother Nature sends us a cooler summer with the occasional rain shower.



Here are a few reminders as we head into the heart of the season:

Remember to thoroughly rake your bunker. Enter and exit the bunker from the backside, NOT THE FRONT FACE. Entering and exiting through the front face will disrupt the cement liner and cause it to break and surface. Bunker rakes are to be placed inside the bunkers with the handle resting on the grass. See photo to left.


The yellow stakes on either side of the fairways near the approach are there to remind you to get your cart to the path BEFORE you pass them. Please don't drive past them. Those that have a blue handicap flag can advance closer to the green. If you require a blue handicap flag for your cart, get one from the golf shop before you head out to play. So, basically, if you don't have a blue flag, don't drive past the yellow stakes! For more information, please inquire with the golf shop.

Please remember to fix your ball mark. Attached is an illustration on the proper way. Don't use a tee. Use a proper repair tool.

The Proper Way to Repair a Ball Mark




1 Use a prolonged ball mark repair tool (preferably), knife, key or tee.




2 Insert at the edges of the mark—not the middle of the depression.



3 Bring the edges together with a gentle twisting motion, but don't lift the center. Try not to tear the grass.



4 Smooth the surface with a club or foot. You're done when it's a surface that you would putt over.

We will also be starting to offer specials each week and we have been working on a new menu which will be rolled out by the middle of July.

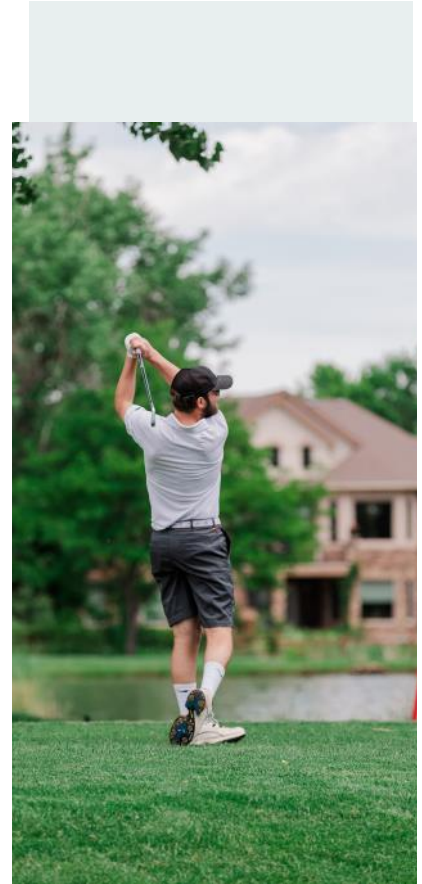
