Rich's Turf Talk

Last month I reported that the golf course was in pretty rough shape due to the extended warm/dry fall and winter. The snow cover from January through mid-March was great, but it didn't have much moisture with it. As the turf began to break dormancy in April, we were able to get a better understanding of the repair work needed. The greens came out of dormancy in very good shape. All other areas of the course took some damage. Some areas, more than others. Over the last month and a half we've been aerifying and groove-seeding most of the damaged areas. To date, we've applied over 4,000 lbs of grass seed. It's encouraging to see some of the first areas we've done begin to germinate and fill in. We'll continue to work on these spots in addition to our general maintenance. To aid in the recovery, I'm asking ALL MEMBERS to help us out by not driving in any thin turf areas. In addition, please continue to obey all cart signage throughout the course. So, basically, if there's a cart path, use it.

Sod is scheduled to arrive next week for the bunkers on Holes #11 & #14. Once it is rooted, they will be back in-play.

Don't forget, Monday, May 2nd is our annual Divot Day. Please join us on the course to help fill divots from 3-5PM. Meet at the Putting Green. Then, head out to the course and fill fairway and tee divots. There will be utility carts located throughout the course filled with sand and seed mix. This is also a great time to clear out all those sand/seed bottles from your garage and trunks and bring back to The Club.

I would like to introduce you to our Assistant-in-Training, Dylan Gardner. You may remember him from last year working in the Golf Shop. Dylan has decided to come to the "Dark Side" of the golf department. His focus will be irrigation troubleshooting and repair. So, if you see him on the course, congratulate him.




Here are a few reminders as we head into full swing:
Remember to thoroughly rake your bunker. Enter and exit the bunker from the backside, NOT THE FRONT FACE. Entering and exiting through the front face will disrupt the cement liner and cause it to break and surface.
Bunker rakes are to be placed inside the bunkers with the handle resting on the grass.







- Please remember to fix your ball mark. Attached is an illustration on the proper way. Don't use a tee. Use a proper repair tool.

The Proper Way to Repair a Ball Mark



- 1** Use a prolonged ball mark repair tool (preferably), knife, key or tee.
- 2** Insert at the edges of the mark—not the middle of the depression.
- 3** Bring the edges together with a gentle twisting motion, but don't lift the center. Try not to tear the grass.
- 4** Smooth the surface with a club or foot. You're done when it's a surface that you would putt over.

Course Changes:

If you have not played the course yet this year or haven't noticed yet we have made some modifications to marking the course. The right side of hole #12 following the edge of the creek is being marked as a red penalty area. The fence line beyond the creek will be played as out of bounds. This change was implemented to remain consistent between hole 12 & 13 where out of bounds is defined by the fence line of the homeowners. Having a red penalty area should also help golfers making the course slightly easier and as well speed up pace of play. Now you can drop where your ball last crossed vs. heading back to the tee to hit a 2nd.

Rules Reminders:

Penalty Areas: As part of rule 17 regarding penalty areas your ball is in a penalty area when any part of it lies on or touches the ground or anything else inside the edge of the penalty area, or is above the edge or any other part of the penalty area.

Out of Bounds: As part of rule 18 regarding out of bounds A ball at rest is out of bounds only when all of it is outside the boundary edge of the course.
