Golf Happenings from Brett:

Members,

Here are a few important things to remember as we move into the colder season. We have had our first frost and want to remind everyone of the procedures.

- * If you have an early tee time make sure to check the home page on Foretees as it will be updated by Rich each morning with information regarding course conditions for the day.
- * Frost is unpredictable sometimes in the sense that we don't always know when it will clear so please check for updates to your tee time. Foretees will send you an email when your tee time is moved due to frost.
- * Check in with the Golf Shop! This is extremely important for the staff to let you know what is going on with course conditions and to ensure everyone is on the same page. You will also get to see a friendly face.
- * All players must adhere to their tee time if it has been moved due to frost. Players that skip ahead of other groups will not be tolerated as this puts undue stress on the maintenance staff and can also cause damage to the course.
- * For those members that live around the course and drive their personal carts to the Clubhouse in the mornings, PLEASE keep your cart on the paths at all times. There are times it may look like there is not frost. That may not be that case.



* Lastly, while under a frost delay, the Driving Range, Chipping Green, and Putting Greens are part of the course and are CLOSED until the frost is gone.

We appreciate everyone's help and cooperation with these procedures as it protects the course and allows the staff time to prepare for the day.

By the start of November, leaf clean up will be in full swing. Removing leaves is an important task because the grass will die if it is left under a wet matting of fall leaves. Leaves can be either removed or mulched. At Fox Hill, we mulch all the leaves. This is a lengthy process that lasts well into December. Mulching leaves is beneficial because it returns organic matter and nutrients back to the soil and can be accomplished much quicker than leaf removal.

The cooler temperatures will also slow the growth of the turf and prepare it for wither dormancy. We need **YOUR** help in preventing excess wear to the course as we head into the off-season. The course receives a lot of play through the winter, and damage to the turf does not recover nearly as quickly as it does in the summer. In fact, once December starts, there's basically no turf recovery until spring. All cart traffic needs to begin to utilize the paths as much as possible during your round of golf. As you are nearing the green, get onto the path and stay on it through the following tee. The only carts that should ever be closer than 30 yards from the green are those that have the blue handicap flags. At the tee and green, park your cart with all 4 tires on the path. These are high traffic areas. Parking half-on and half-off the path only puts unnecessary stress on the turf, and it's one less area we should need to repair. From time to time we may limit a hole or more to cart path only. If and when that happens, you will be notified when you check-in with the golf shop.

Tuesday, November 15th will be the last day to post scores for the season. At that time we will remove the tee markers. Please vary your teeing area as to not create excessive wear to the tee boxes. Before the ground freezes, we will install 3 cups on the greens. While playing this winter, please rotate the flagstick to a different hole.

In addition to leaf cleanup and getting the course ready for winter, we'll begin working on a laundry list of off-season projects. Here's a list of some items you will see us working to improve:

- Adding sand to **ALL** bunkers to achieve a depth of 2-4" on the faces and 4-6" at the bases.
- We've also picked 5 more of the worst bunkers to renovate. This will include bringing the shape of the bunker back to its original size, adding sand and sodding the edges in the spring.
- Tree work will consist of roughly 20 removals along with selective pruning to many more.
- Addition of sprinklers along the lake edge on hole #7. Currently this area does not receive adequate irrigation to maintain turf. Thank you the MGA for graciously funding this improvement!



Lastly, I would like to wish my sidekick, Mr. Nico, a happy birthday. He turns 16 on Halloween. He's been with me and here at The Club since he was 8 weeks old. He doesn't chase the geese like he use to and spends more time in my office than on the course. Thanks to everyone that asks about him and for being so good to him.






