Golf Happenings from Brett:

Tee Time Reservation Policy Change

Beginning October 15th, each Member will be able to make up four (4) tee times during the same day. As in the past, the names of players for each of the times being booked must be entered in Fore Tees. This change is designed to better accommodate groups of Members and families who regularly play together.

Tuesday Ladies Play

On each Tuesday morning we have a block of tee times set aside for ladies play. These times are open to all ladies. Generally, Tuesday Ladies Play includes an optional WGA game where WGA Members compete for golf shop merchandise credit. The format for the WGA game is set by the golf shop and changes each week.

Friday Men's Play:

On each Friday afternoon, we have a block of tee times set aside for a men's game. All men are invited to play but times are limited and are awarded on the first-come, first-served basis. Groups are made at random by the golf shop, giving Members the opportunity to meet and play with new people. The format is also set up by the golf shop and changes each week. The "Friday Game" is a great way to get to get to know new members and play fun, competitive golf.

I can't believe summer is gone. It seems like only yesterday we were preparing the course for spring play. Don't put those clubs away just yet. October can provide some of the best golfing conditions of the entire year. That is, if you don't mind searching for your ball through all the leaves.

The greens healed in very well from aerification performed back in late August. Most tees and approaches are complete as well. We'll be picking away at groove-seeding the fairways and rough throughout the fall as time allows.

The new sewer connection to the clubhouse is complete and as I write this article the lift station is being demolished. Our plan is to landscape the area this winter. While the range has been closed for the sewer project, we were able to get in and seed a section of the landing area. We'll continue to work on seeding more as time and labor allows. I appreciate your cooperation and understanding during this process.

Don't forget to sign-up for the Heaven/Hell golf on Saturday, October 15th. This is a **FUN** 2-person tee time event. So, you can play anytime throughout the day. Make your own twosome. Entry fee for the event is \$20/person. The front 9 will be set-up very easy and the back 9 will be set-up very difficult. If you do not have anyone to play with, contact the golf shop and they can help pair you with someone.

As we head into fall and then winter, the cooler nighttime temperatures will cause frost on the course. Frost delays will become a regular occurrence. We may need to delay starting tee times until it is melted and we can get out and prepare the course for play. To better communicate to you as to when we have delays and how long they will be, I will be posting this information on the ForeTees home page for Fox Hill. It will be located on the left side column under current conditions.

In addition, for those members that live around the course and travel to the Clubhouse in their personal carts, <u>PLEASE</u> stay on the cart paths for the entire trip through the course. For example, if you are entering the course from behind #14 Tee, do not cut across 13 and 16 fairways to get to the Clubhouse. Instead, please travel down hole 13 to 12 to 11 and 10 then to the Clubhouse. I understand this take a little longer, but this is needed to prevent damage to the course.

In addition, when we have delays due to frost, please keep off of the putting green, chipping green and driving range until golf balls are put out.

A few reminders going into fall and winter:

- Please utilize the cartpaths when traveling to the Clubhouse in the mornings. This will prevent YOU doing damage to the course when there is frost on the turf.
- Utilize the sand/seed mix to fill your divots.
- Remember to fix your ballmarks on the greens.
- Bunkers get raked after you hit from them.
- For those that golf with a cart, please obey the yellow stakes and direct your cart to the paths and stay on until after the next tee. The only carts allowed closer to the green and teeing areas are those that have the blue handicap flag.

When parking at the green and teeing areas, keep all 4 tires of your golf cart on the path.




